Sick Leave	Capts are entitled to sick leave due to health problems. The company doesn't provide fixed sick leave days because all annual income shall pay for Capt's productivities.				
Commuting Travel	CES provides 12 return ticket sets per calendar year for the Capt from the pilot's nearest MU port to Shanghai (or wherever rostered to pick up the line flying or attend training etc) that are confirmed economy class (business upgrade may be available to purchase, which the Extra Air Travel allowance could be used for). Within the 12 tickets allocated per calendar year, family member tickets are available on a standby economy class basis.				
Staff Travel	CES provides from the 6th month after the start of contract, valid access to China Eastern(MU) and Skyteam staff travel for discounted tickets as per the IATA ZED-MIBA (Zonal Employee Discount Agreement-Multilateral Interline Business Agreement) policies of the staff travel. (This is same policy for Chinese pilots)				
Insurance	Accident Insurance provided by CES.  Expat Medical Insurance can be provided by the Broker.				
Social Security Insurances	Comprises of Pension, Medical, Unemployment Insurances. According to Chinese Labor Law, both Capt (approx one third) and CES (approx two thirds) shall pay social security fee. Based upon social security fee percentage of 2024, the amount from the Capt is about USD548 per month, which is collected monthly from the Capt's from after-tax monthly remuneration. The majority of the social security fee (Pension component) can be refunded to the pilot after the expiry of the labor contract, and transferred outside China.				
Hotel Accommodations	CES will provide hotel accomodations in China during screening till the start of contract.  Layover hotel accommodation and meals are provided (4 star) by CES.				
Ground Transport	CES provides ground transport at base between HQ to the relevant airport/aircraft.  Layover ground transport between airport and hotel are provided by CES.				
Tax	After tax means after Chinese personal income tax, not any other countries income tax.
